 Televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, air conditioners, computers, machines. and small appliances using fluorocarbon will not be collected by the city.

Fiven if it is written on the back page, items that can fit into designated 201 nonburnable garbage bags excluding sheets and beddings, will be collected.

- Segregate and use the designated bag for garbage, and place trash Try to keep collection location clean and clear from stray garbage. on collection location by no later than 8:30 am
  - It is illegal to burn trash on any property in Kamogawa City.
- Always seal your garbage and recycling bags tightly. Do not bring any garbage from outside Kamogawa City.

#### Clothes cannot be recycled when wet. On rainy days, put paper in a designated recycling bag or wait for the next collection day. Innerwear, underwear, and socks are disposed with burnable garbage. Remove labels and wash before disposing Large items should be stacked and secured with cord. Use a designated garbage bag for smaller items. To not toor the tray to nieros. Be sure that the travs will not be blown around by the wind on collection Stained travs are to be disposed with burnable aarbage Rease see the "Oversized Waste" part on the next page

(Bring receipts of utility bills, mail, etc. that shows the location of the garbage pick-up.)

- Please cut grass and trees into 50 cm long and 10 cm thick. (in the amount of one light truck)
- No need for designated bag for industrial garbage. This type will be weighed and charged.
- Please be careful when passing large vehicles and passing through the site.


