- Prepare a bucket filled with water when planning to light any fireworks.
- Do not set off fireworks when it is windy.
- Take care of your hands, face, and body when lighting any fireworks. Take extra precaution when a lit firework doesn't go off.
- Do not destroy or cut and fireworks.

## Be careful around wild animals!

Please take the following precautions when dealing with wild animals. Do not approach animals you see.

Leave the area slowly and quietly to avoid an attack.

Do not raise your voice, throw things at, or antagonize the animal.

Do not feed animals out in the wild. This can lead to a variety of problems down the line.

### Take special precautions with wild boars and monkeys.

Boars: A boar will charge at you with its tusks when angry and can be very dangerous.

Monkeys: Do not look a monkey in the eyes as this can cause it to get more angry and attack.

## Information about Child Support Allowances

If you are receiving child allowances you will get this paperwork in the mail. You have until August 31<sup>st</sup> to submit your information. They will ask about your income for the past year and for information about your children. You must submit this paperwork to keep getting your allowances.

### Where to submit paperwork:

- Fureai Center, Child Support Division

### What to bring:

- personal seal (*hanko*)
- your and your child's health insurance cards
- \*If you are already getting allowances\* certification of allowances

### Notice: Job search help for those getting child support allowances!

There will be a special job consultation window open to people/families receiving child allowances. Whether you are looking for a part-time job or to be a full-time employee, you can work with someone to match you to a job fitting your needs and schedule. There is no reservation necessary.

- ... you may be able to apply for this special kind of "disaster insurance".
