○ **Getting vaccinations:**

- The date/ timeline for getting vaccines is based on your child's age.
- There is always a period of time between the shots.
- There will be vaccinations that can be done at the same time as others.
- Please ask the hospital or your doctor about the best schedule for your child's vaccinations.

BCG, measles, rubella, chickenpox, Japanese encephalitis

② **Vaccines that cost money (for those who want them):**
Mumps, Influenza (flu shot)
