Kinds of garbage		How to throw
Raw Garbage		Drain water then throw with combustible garbage (orange plastic).
Underwear, socks, hats, bags		Combustible (orange plastic)
Styro foams	Big size	Tie it in a cross with a string
	Cannot be tied	Recyclable garbage (plastic with green colored writings)
	Colored and dirty styro-foams.	Combustible (orange plastic)
Umbrella	Outer canopy	Combustible (orange plastic)
	Shaft	Hardware (plastic with yellow writings)
Spray cans		Make sure the can is empty and no more gas inside. Throw with Empty cans (plastic with green writings)

**Don't leave your dog's feces anywhere, bring them home.**

1. Bring your Residence Card
2. The Citizen Affairs Division staff will make the paper applications for the documents you need.
3. Check if the completed documents are correct. If they are correct, write down your name.
