




End of the year (December 28 to 31) cleaning.

Separate lighters and batteries from burnable garbage.


It is very dangerous to throw the following with burnable garbage.

Туре	Garbage bag / How to throw
Dry cell battery	Recyclable garbage (bag with green labels) Box located at city hall and community centers.
Small batteries	Recyclable garbage (bag with green labels) %dead batteries
Match/Fireworks	Burnable garbage (orange bag) *Even if it is not used, soak in water before throwing.
Lighters	Non-burnable garbage (bag with yellow labels) *Empty lighters before throwing.
Spray cans· Gas tanks	Recyclable garbage (bag with green labels) **Empty before throwing out.
