★ Direct payments: the money will automatically be deducted from your account on the due date.
★ Through direct payments, paying a month, 6 months, 1 year, or 2 years worth in advance, is cheaper than paying in cash.

In winter, when the wind is strong and the air is dry, fires are more likely to start.

Do not burn garbage from home by yourself.

If you wish to burn grass in your field, please apply at the Kamogawa Fire Department.

1. Do not do it alone.
2. Prevent on doing it on a strong windy day.
3. Prepare fire extinguishing tools to put out the fire when it spreads.
4. Cut the surrounding grass. (to prevent fire from spreading)
5. Be cautious and inform your neighbors when you plan to burn grass or rice straws.
