Dog registration and Rabies vaccination.

From April 17 (Thu.), you can register and have your dog vaccinated at locations near where you live.

- You can have it done at locations other than the ones near your area.
- Dogs older than 91 days must be registered and vaccinated.
- ★A medical questionnaire will be sent to registered dog owners.
