## Pet Disaster Preparedness and Recovery.



- Make sure your pets are microchipped and your information is registered.

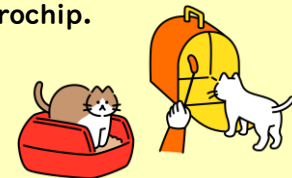
In case you lost your pet during a disaster, the authority will be able to contact you with the information on the microchip.

- Pet training and discipline.

It is to not bother other people.

Make sure to familiarize your pets with where they will urinate and poo.

Make sure your pets are clean, completed vaccinations, and got anti-parasite treatment.



- Prepare an emergency bag for your pet.

3 to 5 days worth of supplies.

Prepare: water, pet food, medication, disposable pet sheets (toilet items), collar or leash, cage, carriers, record of pet and vaccine information, gum tape, toys, etc.
