USE DESIGNATED BAGS AND PROPERLY SEPARATE YOUR GARBAGE

Charge for combustible garbage (beneficiary payment system) ~ Garbage reduction and recycling ~ Toward a resource recycling society

BURNABLE WASTE	① BURNABLE Kitchen waste, waste paper, plastic, rubber, shell, etc.	EVERY WEEK AND 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please cut grass, branches, etc. into pieces less than 50 cm in length and less than 10 cm thick. Compost grass, twigs, and kitchen scraps as much as possible. Do not throw with recyclable and non-burnable garbage. Drain water from kitchen waste. Dispose of cooking oil by soaking it in napkins or chemically solidifying it. Clean soiled diapers before disposing them. Cut rope and vinyl hose into 50 cm pieces before throwing. Cut sheets into 50 cm. square pieces. Files, albums, etc. should be removed and put out with the metals.

NONBURNABLE WASTE	② METAL Cooking supplies, electric devices, scissors, wire, razors, hangers, umbrella frames, lighters, electric thermometers	The 2nd and 4th 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wrap sharp metal objects (scissors, knives, razors) in paper, write the contents. Make sure there is no gas left in any lighters before throwing. Remove batteries from electronic appliances. Remove vinyl from umbrellas and throw out with burnable. Paint or spray cans should be empty and washed before disposing.
	③ GLASS • CERAMICS Glass, cups, light bulbs, glasses, mirrors, plates, vases, flowerpots, cosmetic containers, etc.	The 2nd and 4th 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dispose of fluorescent lights as hazardous waste Broken glass and other dangerous objects should be wrapped in paper. Write the contents on the paper. Stone bath mats (that contain asbestos): contact the store where you bought them.
	④ HAZARDOUS Fluorescent lights, thermometers, mercury lamps, etc.	 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dispose of fluorescent lights to stick out if they cannot fit in the bag. Be sure to seal the bag Dispose of fluorescent lights in the container they originally came in with. This will reduce breakage.
	⑤ CANS Drink cans, food cans, spray cans, seasoning cans, gas canisters, etc.	The 1st, 3rd, and 5th 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remove contents, rinse, and crush before throwing out There is no need to separate aluminum and steel cans - you can put them in the same bag Please release gas from spray cans before disposing them
RECYCLABLE WASTE	⑥ BOTTLES Drink, food, and seasoning bottles, etc.	The 1st and 3rd 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dispose of the cap separately (burnable or metal) Remove the contents and rinse Cosmetic bottles are to be disposed of with glass and ceramics. Consult with the store of purchase regarding medicine bins Cover broken bins or glass with paper, dispose with glass and ceramics
	⑦ PET BOTTLES Drink bottles, Seasoning bottles (as long as there is no oil)	On the <input type="checkbox"/> and <input type="checkbox"/> Wednesday		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only recycle bottles with the "PET" mark Remove the cap, drain contents, and rinse bottles before recycling. Dispose of plastics with the "プラ" mark as burnable waste Dirty or stained bottles are considered burnable.
	⑧ BATTERIES Alkaline batteries, manganese batteries, rechargeable batteries, lithium batteries	The 2nd and 4th 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please dispose of alkaline, manganese, and rechargeable batteries. (Mobile batteries, electronic cigarettes, and wireless earphones are acceptable) There are battery disposal boxes available at City Hall, Fureai Center, Community Centers, and Branch Offices
SECURELY TIE WITH CORD	⑨ PAPER Newspaper, magazines, cardboard, paper drink packs, miscellaneous paper	On the <input type="checkbox"/> and <input type="checkbox"/> Wednesday		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Separate each type of paper and tie securely with cord. Group notices and advertisements with newspaper Wet paper cannot be recycled. On rainy days, put paper in a designated recycling bag or wait for the next collection day. Paper packs with silver lining are burnable waste You can leave the staples on paper
	⑩ CLOTH Clothes, sheets, towel, blankets	 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fold, stack, and tie the items with a cord Clothes cannot be recycled when wet. On rainy days, put paper in a designated recycling bag or wait for the next collection day. Futons, blankets, and carpets must be disposed of as oversized garbage Innerwear, underwear, and socks are disposed with burnable garbage
	⑪ WHITE TRAYS AND STYROFOAMS The trays used in packing meat, fish, and vegetables, styrofoams	The 2nd and 4th 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remove labels and wash before disposing Large items should be stacked and secured with cord. Use a designated garbage bag for smaller items Do not tear the tray to pieces Be sure that the trays will not be blown around by the wind on collection day Stained trays are to be disposed with burnable garbage
RESERVATION SYSTEM	⑫ OVERSIZED Household electronics, furniture, bicycles, etc. (For a specific list, see the backside of the handout)	EVERY WEEK (Excluding the 5th <input type="checkbox"/>)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please see the "Oversized Waste" part on the next page Televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, air conditioners, computers, machines, and small appliances using fluorocarbon will not be collected by the city. (See back page for more details) Even if it is written on the back page, items that can fit into designated 20L non-burnable garbage bags excluding sheets and beddings, will be collected.

- Segregate and use the designated bag for garbage, and place trash on collection location by no later than 8:30 am.
- Always seal your garbage and recycling bags tightly.
- Try to keep collection location clean and clear from stray garbage.
- It is illegal to burn trash on any property in Kamogawa City.
- Do not bring any garbage from outside Kamogawa City.

Types of Garbage bags

- Please use the designated bags by referring to "USE DESIGNATED BAGS AND PROPERLY SEPARATE YOUR GARBAGE".
- Follow the proper steps when disposing of nonburnable garbage and recyclables.
- The designated bags for the burnable garbage have a certificate stamp on it, so put them out directly to the collection location.
- Nonburnable waste and recyclables are charged only for the bag fee.

Garbage Reduction

- Take time to properly sort nonburnable and recyclables from burnable waste. Let's reduce burnable waste.
- Drain water from raw garbage and turn it into compost material when possible.
- Do your best to finish all of your food and reduce food waste.

DISPOSING RECYCLABLES

CANS

Wash the inside of the can and then crush.

BOTTLES

Remove the cap. (Dispose the cap with burnable garbage or metal) Wash the inside of the bin.

PET BOTTLES

Remove the cap, seal, remove the content then wash the inside. Crush it with your foot

Pet bottle caps are being recycled; the collection location is the same with batteries.

BATTERIES

1. Use designated bag before disposing
2. Dispose in battery boxes located in some city facilities.
*Remove from bag and put in the box.
(Battery box locations: City Hall, Amatsu-Kominato Branch Office, Branch Offices, Community Centers, Fureai Center)
**Not available on days the facilities are closed.

NEWSPAPERS

Stack and tie with a string. (Stacks should be no more than 40 cm high)

CARDBOARD

Open and flatten completely. Stack and tie with string.

MAGAZINES

Stack and tie with a string. (Stacks should be no more than 40 cm high)

DRINK CARTONS

Wash Cut Stack and tie with string. Let dry.

MISCELLANEOUS PAPER (RECYCLED PAPER)

Snack boxes, empty tissue boxes, wrapping paper, paper core of toilet papers, paper packaging of canned beverages, flyers or pamphlets, note, clothing pattern. (Remove veneers and silver/metal linings)

Stack and tie with string. Smaller items can be put in a paper bag and tied.

CLOTHES

All buttons and fasteners can be left attached. Tie items and tie with string. Try to keep it clean and dry (otherwise it won't be recycled)

WHITE TRAYS/STYROFOAMS

Remove labels then wash. Let dry. Stack and tie. If it cannot be stacked, use and put in the bag for recycled waste.

TRANSPARENT EGG PACKS / PS LABELED PACKS AND LIDS

Remove seal and wash before recycling. (If seal won't come off, cut with scissors)
(Recycle Boxes located at: City Hall, Amatsu-Kominato Branch Office, Branch Offices, Community Centers, and Fureai Center)

Go to one of the facilities included under "TICKET VENDORS", give your reservation number, and pay for the ticket.

PUT OUT ITEMS AT COLLECTION LOCATION

Put the ticket stickers on the oversized waste, place them on the location by 8:30 am on that day.

COLLECTION

Personnel will collect your oversized waste.

* Tickets are non-refundable. * If you miss the collection date, have it collected on the next collection day. Be sure to call the Garbage Center.
* If you have a large amount of waste due to moving or business-related waste, please bring it yourself or ask a city-licensed contractor to do so. (List on next page)
