Measles-Rubella (MR) 	Those born on April 2, 2019 to April 1, 2020.	March 31, 2026
Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus (DPT)/ DPT-IPV, Polio	11 to 12 years old	Before 13 th birthday 
HPV (Only for women) 	Those born on April 2, 1997 to April 1, 2009 and had their first shot between 2022 to 2024.	March 31, 2026
	Those born on April 2, 2009 to April 1, 2010.	
	Those born on April 2, 2010 to April 1, 2014.	March 31 of 1 st year of high school
Shingles in the elderly 	Those who will be 65, 70, 75, ... 100 years old on April 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026. 100 years old and above, 60 to 64-year olds who are sick.	March 31, 2026
