## Please cooperate with recycling!

★ Empty cans of drinks, cooking ingredients, etc.,:

- 1 Make sure to empty the cans.
- 2 Wash the inside.
- 3 Use the recyclable garbage bag and dispose on “Empty cans” day.



★ High-pressure gas cylinders used in sodas or draft beers:

Return used high-pressure gas tanks to where it's being made or to the place of purchase.

Non high-pressured gas tanks should be disposed with “Hardware” garbage.



★ Empty bottles of drinks, cooking ingredients, food, etc.,:

- 1 Throw lids with combustible or recyclable garbage.
- 2 Make sure that the bottles are empty.
- 3 Wash the inside and throw with recyclable garbage.



★ Used glass cosmetic containers and broken glass:

- 1 Wrap broken glass with paper.
- 2 On the wrapping, write the content.
- 3 Throw with non-combustible garbage.



★ Bottles of medicine, disinfectants received from hospitals, or vaccine bottles:

## Pet Disaster Preparedness and Recovery.



• Make sure your pets are microchipped and your information is registered.

In case you lost your pet during a disaster, the authority will be able to contact you with the information on the microchip.

• Pet training and discipline.

It is to not bother other people.

Make sure to familiarize your pets with where they will urinate and poo.

Make sure your pets are clean, completed vaccinations, and got anti-parasite treatment.



• Prepare an emergency bag for your pet.

3 to 5 days worth of supplies.

Prepare: water, pet food, medication, disposable pet sheets (toilet items), collar or leash, cage, carriers, record of pet and vaccine information, gum tape, toys, etc.



• Pet-friendly evacuation site.

Put your pet in a cage and go to Kominato Satoumi School (Uchiura 1891-1).



## Proper pet care check.

DOGS:

- Keep the leash short when walking your dog.
- Make sure to immediately close the gate or door to prevent your dog from going outside alone
- If your dog bites someone, contact the Health Center immediately.
- Please see the vet to check for rabies.



CATS:

- Let us keep cats inside the house.
- There are those who don't like the smell of cat litter, and gets irritated with cat noises.
