|                |               | Float and portable shrines of each shrine (6 shrines)            |

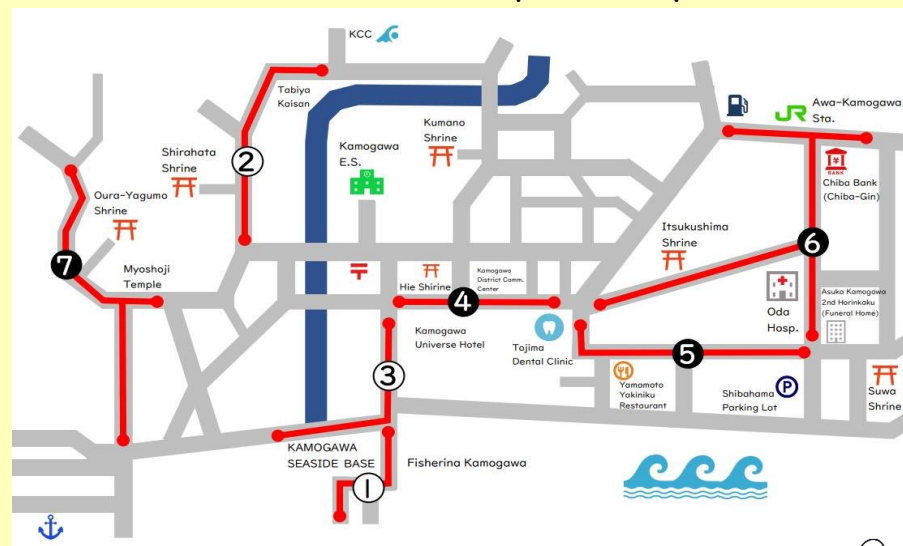
### Closed routes & time for all moving vehicles:
