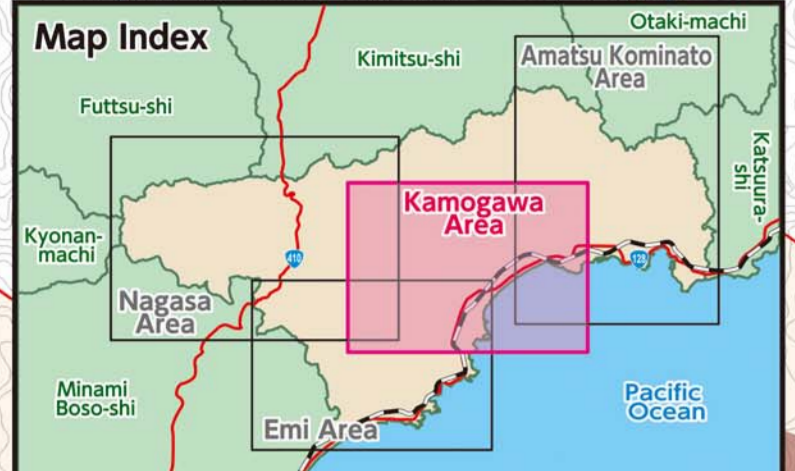

Tsunami Flood Zones

Flood zone estimates are based on the 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake where waves reached 10m tall.

*This map is a reference for a 10m tall wave striking the coast. Depending on the circumstances, waves may not end up reaching land or they may reach land and be even larger than forecasts predict.

After an earthquake begins a typhoon can reach shore in as little as 5 minutes

Average distance a person can travel in 5 minutes

- Leisurely Pace: 150m
- Normal Walking: 300m
- Running: 500~600m

Emergency Evacuation Area: An area designated to provide immediate safety from a disaster. Evacuation Area: An area designated to provide shelter and support for disaster victims. Functions may change depending on the disaster.

*In the event of an earthquake (not including a tsunami), there may not be a need to evacuate to a designated Evacuation Area. If your house sustains any damages, wait for the shaking to stop before calmly making your way to an evacuation area.

*In the event of a tsunami, please take immediate action to evacuate to a designated Evacuation Area or to a nearby tall building. Depending on conditions, the size of tsunami may be bigger or smaller than forecasts predict.

Kamogawa Emergency Alert Service

Receive emergency and disaster information directly to you phone or personal computer, including information on earthquakes, typhoons, evacuation procedures, fires, and missing or suspicious persons.

Kamogawa River Flood Zone

This zone is based on investigations by Chiba Prefecture of expected flood zones. The depth and area affected, shown in different colors, is calculated based on flooding conditions for 291mm of rain in 24hrs. The area highlighted in purple shows the flood area for the strongest storm in recent history (occurring on August 26th, 2005).

During heavy storms, information on evacuation procedure will be announced by the headquarters for emergency disaster control. However, if you feel you are in danger please take immediate action to evacuate. Floods may occur outside of the marked regions, please take proper precautions to safeguard you and your family.
