NORTH AND SOUTH ROUTES 10 YEN~ 20 YEN PRICE INCREASE

Starting October 1st, the North-bound route [Kanayama Dam to Uchiurayama Kenmin no Mori] and the South-bound [Soro-shuten to Awa-Kamogawa Station] will have a price change depending on the area of the route. Prices will increase anywhere from 10 to 20 yen. Please take note of the change.

The Kiyosumi route will not be affected by these changes at this time. The price increase is to maintain changes with the tax price increase happening this year.

CHANGES TO THE NORTH-BOUND ROUTE SCHEDULE

Also effective October 1st, the North-bound route [Kanayama Dam to Uchiurayama Kenmin no Mori] will stop offering a special weekend bus schedule.
