Disaster Certification • Disaster Damage Report Certification

People who have had damage to their homes or properties may be eligible for disaster certification or disaster damage report certification.

Hours: Weekdays 8:30AM - 5:15 PM (Tuesdays: until 7:00PM)
Where: Kamogawa City Hall 1F Tax Department
What you need: Pictures of the damage, personal seal, an official quote/estimate for the damage, and personal identification

Disaster Waste Disposal Information

Accepted waste items: Ceramic roofing tiles (Kawara), metal items, metal siding/roofing panels (totan), wood (under 1 meter in length), branches, tatami mats, wood scraps, PVC siding/roofing panels (PVC totan), gutters, slate/exterior materials, columns/pillars, plywood, futon bedding, electrical appliances, glass, concrete (blocks and rubble)

Take items to: Site of the Former Kamogawa City - Minami-boso City Environmental Health Association (497-1 Nishi-Emi, Kamogawa)

All those working at businesses within the prefecture (including part-time workers) will all be experiencing a pay raise to 923 yen an hour. Transportation, family and time benefits will not be included in this change.

KAMOGAWA PREMIUM GIFT CERTIFICATE INFORMATION

Those with children under the age of 3 and people who don't have to pay citizen taxes in Kamogawa are eligible to purchase premium gift certificates. Those eligible have already been sent information in the mail.

To buy, bring your purchasing voucher and a form of personal identification (A license, My Number Card, Health insurance Card, or foreign residence card) and head over to a post office within the city. (Except for the Saijo Express Post Office)
