TIPS FOR FLU PREVENTION!

Ways to Prevent the Flu: Avoid contact with large crowds

Every year the flu starts to spread at the start of winter but this year flu outbreaks have been starting earlier. It is easily spread and will have symptoms including fever, headaches, sore joints, and overall effects on the body.

There is a 24-72 hour period which no symptoms will appear. Usually the flu will take between 2 and 7 days to get cleared from the system. But this can be complicated or prolonged by other illnesses. Children, the elderly, and people with heart, lung, or immune system problems are especially at risk for the flu becoming a more serious health problem.
