## New Kamogawa - Kimitsu Bus Route!

Starting from April 1st, 2020 a new bus route connecting Kamogawa with Kimitsu will begin service. This bus will start from Kameda Medical Center and will go through Kimitsu Bus Terminal, ultimately ending up at Kimitsu Station- South Entrance. From the Kimitsu Bus terminal, riders can access Haneda Airport and Shinjuku with ease. We hope it will make travelling and commuting more convenient. It will also allow visitors coming from Kimitsu and the major cities to more easily access Kamogawa!

When: April 1st to September 30th [6 months]
