

DON'T CAUSE FIRES WITH YOUR GARBAGE!

The following items can be quite dangerous and cause fires if not properly thrown away. Please take care to properly get rid of them.



Lithium-ion batteries:

These batteries found in handheld electronics should be brought directly to the Garbage Center or taken to the store they were bought at for disposal.

Matches and Fireworks:

For garbage items that pose a huge risk of starting a fire, they should be separated from combustible garbage and taken directly to the Garbage Center.

Used lighters:

Empty used lighters and throw out with "Metals".

Gas cannisters and spray cans:

Empty cans and throw out with "Cans".

INFORMATION ABOUT CHILD REARING ALLOWANCES

The Child Support Division will send out information to families getting child rearing allowances. If you are receiving these allowances and get this paperwork in the mail, you have until August 30th to submit your information in order to keep getting allowances. They will ask about your income for the past year and for information about your children. You must submit this paperwork to keep getting your allowances.

Where to submit paperwork:

- Fureai Center, Child Support Division

What to bring:

- personal seal (hanko)
- your health insurance card
- your child's health insurance card
- certification of allowances*

*only if you are already getting allowances.

[Stamp Goals!]

- 1 Get a medical examination/checkup!
※ Bring your test results or a receipt from your checkup to one of the locations listed below to get your stamp.
- 2 Get vaccinated or use a proscribed generic medication!
※ Bring a receipt from your vaccination or for your proscribed medication to one of the locations listed below to get your stamp.
- 3 Join a health-related event or activity!
• Volunteer in a health-related event or activity.
• Join a "Well-Kamo Class" or participate in other wellness sport activities.
- 4 Set and complete a personal goal!
• Set a goal and write it down on your stamp sheet. It can be anything from walking everyday to eating a certain amount of vegetables to even quitting smoking!
