Consultation about Filing Taxes

When: February 16th – March 15th ※ Closed weekends, holidays, and March 8th.
8:45 AM – 4PM

Where: Kamogawa City Hall 4F Large Meeting Room

Items Necessary for Filing:

1. Completed tax forms
2. Filing Request Notification (postcard or slip)
3. Any items showing your income for 2021
 - Statement of Earnings for income or pension payments
 - Income itemization list
 - Financial aid you received related to COVID-19
4. Forms/ paperwork related to tax reductions
 - Dependent Support Reductions: (paperwork showing payments to dependents)
 - Health Insurance Reductions: (Certificates, receipts, etc.)
 - Health Care Reductions: (Detailed statement of services, etc.)
 - Disability Reductions: (Disability Booklet (physical, mental))
5. Foreign Residence Card
6. Personal seal
7. Banking Information
 - If you are eligible to get a tax return, please bring the banking information of the person eligible for the return.

Note: Even if you did not have any income in 2021, you should still file your taxes. You will get tax exemption or reduction status.

National Pension Payment Options – Direct Deposit/ Credit Card

There are 2 ways you can get discounts when paying through direct deposit with your bank:

- If you opt to pay slightly ahead of the regular payment schedule with advanced payments
- If you make lump sum payments for set time periods (6 months, 1 year, or 2 years ahead of time)

When applying...

Go to the bank or financial institution you would like to use and ask about this payment program and apply. (※ You can also go to the Kisarazu Pension Office)

If you want to start using this payment method for the next financial year (starting April 2022), please apply by Feb. 28th.

Filing City • Prefectural Taxes

If you have filed these taxes in previous years, a slip will be sent to your house. The city hall is asking that you file this paperwork by mail if possible, to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and reduce the number of people visiting the city hall.
