

Notice: Collection Dates for Oversized Garbage

Oversized garbage collection will change, as of April 1st, 2022 in the following ways:

- ▼ Areas with the Mon./Thurs. burnable garbage schedule: collection is every Thursday
 - ▼ Areas with the Tues./Fri. burnable garbage schedule: collection is every Friday
- ※ *This does not include the 5th Thursday or Friday of the month. Oversized garbage will not be collected on those dates.*



※Places to buy oversized garbage tickets:

- Environmental Division
- Amatsu-Kominato Branch Office
- Fureai Center
- Branch offices (Emi, Yoshio, Kominato)
- Post offices (Kamogawa-Maebara, Tojo, Kamogawa-Tabara, Nagasa, Kozuka, Futomi, Soro)

Reminder: How to throw away oversized garbage

1. Call the Kamogawa Garbage Center (04-7093-5300) by Tuesday of the week you plan to put out items for collection. Tell them your name, address, phone number, and the # of items/ type of oversized garbage you will put out.
 - ※ *The staff at the Garbage Center will give you a reservation number for each item. Please make a note of this number and do not forget it.*
2. Buy the oversized garbage tickets before your collection day ※
3. Write your reservation number on the ticket and stick it to your items.
4. Place your oversized garbage out in your regular collection spot by 8:30AM on collection day.

The evening chime will change back to 6PM on April 1st.

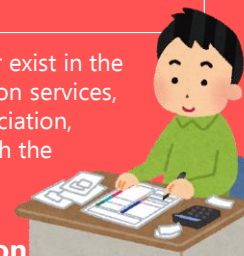
Division and Department Changes at City Hall

Property Tax Payment Notification

If you owned a property or land at any point as of January 1st you will have to pay property taxes. The notification will be sent out at the beginning of April.

This notification will have the amount you owe, the due date, and where you can pay included. If you choose to have payments withdrawn from your bank account, make sure that there is enough money in your account for the payment to be made.
